

# Limpie Tras sus Animales Domésticos

## ¿Por qué limpiar los residuos de animales?

Los residuos de animales contienen bacterias que pueden contaminar el agua pluvial y ser transportadas a nuestros frágiles arroyos del desierto. Pueden dañar el medio ambiente y constituir un riesgo para niños, animales domésticos y fauna silvestre. Deshágalo de los residuos apropiadamente.

## ¿Cómo deshago de residuos de animales domésticos?

Ponga los residuos de su animal doméstico en una bolsa y póngala en la basura. No deje los residuos en su patio y nunca deshaga de ellos en arroyos o en el desierto. Los residuos de animales domésticos no se "desaparecen" y no se convierten en fertilizante.

**¡Póngalo en una bolsa e tírelo a la basura!**

## ¿Qué pasa con el estiércol de caballo?

Cubra el estiércol y transportalo por camioneta o remolque al relleno sanitario. Los residuos de animales domésticos se aceptan por \$10 por tonelada. Las cantidades pequeñas pueden ponerse en una bolsa y depositarse en un contenedor de basura. Para más información, llame a Los Reales Landfill al 791-4183.

## Why clean up animal waste?
